15.	Depending on lice shampoo used, a second treatment in 7-10 days may be required to kill newly hatched lice. Shampoos containing insecticide should not be repeated before 7 days. Check with a pharmacist if you have questions.
14.	For 2-3 weeks after treatment, check daily for nits and remove as needed.
—— ^{13.}	Do not share combs, brushes, caps, etc. Soak personal combs, brushes, and other hair accessories in hot water (above 130 degrees F) for 10 minutes.
12.	Empty vacuum bags and dispose in plastic bags.
11.	Vacuum inside of vehicles.
10.	Clean foors (vacuum or scrub).
9.	Vacuum or wash furniture, rugs, curtains depending on material.
8	Iron, air out, or vacuum mattresses. Do not leave the iron on the mattress an extended period of time to avoid fres.
7.	For any other items that can't be washed or dry cleaned (stuffed animals, comforters), place in plastic bags or trash bags and seal for 3 weeks.
o.	Place pillows in a plastic bag for three weeks or tumble in dryer on high heat for 20 minutes depending on the material.
