



# Head Lice Checklist for Treatment

- 1e. Retreatment is generally recommended for most prescription and non-prescription shampoos containing insecticide should not be repeated before 7 days. Check with a pharmacist if you have questions.
- 12. Depending on lice shampoo used, a second treatment in 7-10 days may be required to kill newly hatched lice.
- 14. For 2-3 weeks after treatment, check daily for nits and remove as needed:
  - (above 130 degrees F) for 10 minutes.
- 13. Do not share combs, brushes, caps, etc. Wash personal combs, brushes, and other hair accessories in hot water.
- 15. Empty vacuum bags and dispose in plastic bags:

- 9. Vacuum of wash furniture, rugs, curtains depending on material:
- 8. Iron, air out, or vacuum mattresses. Do not leave the iron on the mattress an extended period of time to avoid fire:

- 7. For any other items that can't be washed or dry cleaned (stuffed animals, comforters), place in plastic bags or trash bags
- 6. Place pillows in a plastic bag for three weeks or tumble in dryer on high heat for 50 minutes depending on the material.
